Independent Accountant's Report on Applying Agreed-Upon Procedures

We have performed the procedures enumerated below, which were agreed to by St. Francis of Assisi Catholic Church (the Church) and the Roman Catholic Diocese of Dallas (the Diocese), solely to assist you in complying with the requirements set forth by the Diocese as of and for the year ended June 30, 2020. Management of St. Francis of Assisi Catholic Church is responsible for the accounting records of the Church. This agreed-upon procedures engagement was conducted in accordance with attestation standards established by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants. The sufficiency of these procedures is solely the responsibility of those parties specified in the report. Consequently, we make no representation regarding the sufficiency of the procedures described below either for the purpose for which this report has been requested or for any other purpose.

Our procedures and findings are as follows:

- We obtained a copy of the entity's year-end Right Networks (RN) standardized financial report Mid-Level Statement of Financial Position vs. Prior Year, Detail Level Statement of Activities vs. Prior Year-Natural and Detail Level Statement of Activities vs. Budget - Natural as of and for the year ended June 30, 2020. A copy of those financial reports is attached to this report as Exhibit 1. We performed the following procedures with respect to those reports:
 - a. For the Statement of Activities vs. Budget report, we agreed the budgeted financial data for the year ended June 30, 2020, to the approved budget by reference to minutes of the Finance Committee.

No exceptions were noted in performing this procedure.

b. We determined that meetings are held with the Parish Finance Council at least four times a year by reviewing the minutes of said meetings.

No exceptions were noted in performing this procedure.

2. We obtained a list of all accounts at all financial institutions, including account numbers, name, authorized signers, and purpose. The list includes all entities such as trusts, and Church-based organizations. We confirmed that all the accounts on the list are included in the financial reports of the Church. A copy of that list is attached to this report as Exhibit 2.

No exceptions were noted in performing this procedure.

3. We obtained and reviewed the *QuickBooks Reconciliation Detail* for all the bank accounts listed in the attached Exhibit 2, compared the reconciled bank account balance to the *QuickBooks Balance Sheet Summary Report* at June 30, 2020, and examined the date on which each *QuickBooks Reconciliation Detail* was completed to determine whether the respective accounts were reconciled to the general ledger in a timely manner (within 30 days). We also determined if the reconciliation was reviewed by an individual other than the preparer and that such review was documented.

No exceptions were noted in performing this procedure.

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4. Effective January 1, 2020, all parishes transitioned from the existing outside payroll provider (PayChoice) to a new outside payroll provider (Exponent HR). As part of this transition, each parish was to confirm that pertinent employee data (e.g. salary, deductions, etc.) was accurately transferred/loaded from the Sage/PayChoice system to the new Exponent HR system. This confirmation of the employee data took place in connection with the first payroll (i.e. the bi-monthly payroll period ending Jan 15, 2020) processed in the Exponent HR system.

We obtained the documentation underlying the Church's review and confirmation that employee data transferred accurately to the Exponent HR system. We further selected 12 employees, which represented 20% of all employees, and determined that for each selected employee their salary and 403(b) contributions amounts/percentages as noted on the January 15, 2020 payroll agreed to the last payroll register form the PayChoice system.

No exceptions were noted in performing this procedure.

- 5. We selected 12 employees, which represented 20% of all employees, and obtained and reviewed applicable personnel file and salary information to determine the following:
 - a. The salary being paid to each employee had been properly approved.
 - b. I-9 documentation for lay employees hired during the fiscal year had been properly completed and is maintained in a file separate from other personnel records.
 - c. Ascertain through review and testing of a representative sample of stipends paid to all clergy employees, that such payments are being paid through the payroll system and are being included as compensation for tax reporting purposes.
 - d. Each has been enrolled in the diocesan group insurance plan if qualified (working 30 hours or more per week) and the cost of elective coverages has been withheld from pay.
 - e. Employees were properly enrolled (or not) in the 403B plan, and have received the correct matching and mandatory employer contributions for the fiscal year. The status of employees listed as ineligible for the 403(B) plan appeared reasonable.
 - Determine that the employee is <u>properly</u> enrolled in the 403B Plan and received the correct matching and mandatory employer contributions for the fiscal year. (General 403(B) plan rules: (1) an employee can defer at any time. (2) To be eligible for employer contributions, an employee must have worked at least one year and worked more than 1,000 hours in a 12-month period).
 - Review the status of employees listed as ineligible for reasonableness.

No exceptions were noted in performing this procedure.

6. We conducted a walkthrough for on-line giving and Sunday contributions mailed in, from the time contributions are received, deposited in the bank and recorded in the general ledger. We selected five non-consecutive weeks' on-line giving and five nonconsecutive weeks' Sunday contributions mailed in collections' count sheets and tied the sheets to the bank deposit and posting to the general ledger, and the reconciliation with the Parish database of individual contribution record.

No exceptions were noted in performing these procedures with the exception that no reconciliation between individual contribution with the Parish database existed.

7. Step not applicable.

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- 8. We obtained and reviewed a total of 30 haphazardly selected non-payroll disbursements consisting of 10 employee reimbursements and 20 "other" disbursements from the check registers of the Church, plus supporting documentation such as vendor invoices, utility bills, check requests, receipts, and cancelled checks, as applicable, to determine whether:
 - a. The invoice, receipt, or contract is properly approved and attached.
 - b. Employee/priest expense reimbursements are adequately and properly supported.
 - c. Any amounts paid to employees representing compensation was reported via the PayChoice payroll system for inclusion in the employee's W-2 tax form.
 - d. Inquire if the entity pays individuals/workers in cash/or gift cards.
 - e. Review and conclude on the adequacy of procedures for setting up vendors for purposes of 1099 reporting at year-end, including:

Review copies of the 1099 and 1096 tax forms for the prior calendar year.

For the prior calendar year ascertain that a 1099 was prepared for all applicable vendors by reference to the supporting accounts payable report(s). For a sample of five 1099's agree the reported amount to the underlying accounts payable/disbursement records.

Ascertain that 1099 was not given to employees.

No exceptions were noted in performing these procedures.

- 9. We determined that national and special collections are being remitted timely and in the proper amounts:
 - a. We reviewed two special collections remitted to the Diocese. The amounts that make up two special collections are illustrated in the table below:

b. We reviewed the fiscal year-end balances in special collections general ledger accounts #2051 through #2066 and noted no general ledger accounts with amounts in excess of 60 days.

No exceptions were noted in performing these procedures.

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10. We determined that the Church published its prior fiscal year's Right Networks standardized reports: Mid-Level Statement of Activities vs Prior Year – Natural and Mid-Level Statement of Financial Position vs Prior Year by October 15, 2019. The FY 2019 report was issued on September 11, 2019 on the Church's website.

No exceptions were noted in performing these procedures.

11. Meet with the Church's Pastor, Business Manager and Finance Committee and review the results of the annual financial review.

Meeting to be held September 10, 2020.

12. We obtained representation from the Pastor of the Church in the format prescribed by the Diocese.

A copy of the signed representation letter is attached to this report as Exhibit 4.

13. Based on the findings we noted in performing procedures listed above, we noted one area of concern requiring improvements or corrections, and our recommendation is attached to this report as Exhibit 3.

We were not engaged to, and did not conduct an audit, the objective of which would be the expression of an opinion on the accounting records of the Church. Accordingly, we do not express such an opinion. Had we performed additional procedures, other matters might have come to our attention that would have been reported to you.

This report is intended solely for the information and use of management of St. Francis of Assisi Catholic Church and the Roman Catholic Diocese of Dallas and is not intended to be and should not be used by anyone other than these specified parties.

Recommendation Based On Agreed-Upon Procedures Year Ended June 30, 2020

In the year ended June 30, 2020 there was one area noted during the 2020 procedures that warranted recommended correction for the next fiscal year.

No reconciliation exists between the parish database and on-line donations, nor the Parish database and Sunday contributions, because the parish database does not distinguish between on-line and cash/check donations. Additionally one deposit from the on-line giving provider covers a date range of a month and a half, that has crossover dates with the preceding and following deposits. Subsequently, a deposit on the bank reconciliation and general ledger is frequently in a different month from the entries in Parishioners' records, affecting the reconciliations for the surrounding periods.

It is recommended that the Diocese works with the Parish to understand the challenge of filtering a reconciliation from the Parish database to the bank deposits and determine a different course of action to resolve
